# THREE COMMUNITIES LAUNCH NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH

Residents in the Seafort, Hellshire Park
Estate and Fort Hill Estate communities in
Hellshire, St Catherine are now being
served by Neighbourhood Watch groups to
help ensure public safety.

The groups were launched during a ceremony at the Hellshire Park Shopping Centre on March 25. It was attended by Minister of National Security Dr Horace Chang; Commissioner of Police, Major General Antony Anderson and other senior members of the Jamaica Constabulary Force (JCF); Mayor of Portmore, Leon Thomas, Member of Parliament for South St Catherine, Fitz Jackson; Councillor Vanrick Preddie; the All Hellshire Leadership Council Executive, Citizens Associations Presidents, residents and other stakeholders.

Against the background of increased criminal activity in the area, Dr Chang noted that policing alone, "even in its most extreme form", will not be enough to fully ensure public safety without the support of the community. "Having strong community support, working collaboratively with the police, is the surest way of improving public safety and good order in the community," the minister noted.

Commissioner Anderson said that a Neighbourhood Watch can provide the foundation on which the citizens build their communities, reduce the fear of crime, have safer communities and strengthen trust and confidence between the police and citizens. The Commissioner pointed out that through the movement, residents will "get to know their neighbours", noting that "the very nature of a Neighbourhood Watch... means we all 'business in our business'; our collective security is all of our concern". He also lauded the integration of technologies in the programme, pointing out that this is "consistent with the direction that the JCF has moved".

## CCTV GOES LIVE IN HELLSHIRE – AHLC BOOSTS SECURITY COVERAGE

The All Hellshire Leadership Council has activated Phase 1 of the camera surveillance system intended to provide coverage of communities, entry points and vulnerable areas in the Hellshire area. The announcement was made by AHLC Chairman, Delford Julal at the Neighbourhood Watch launch for three communities.

In a multimedia presentation with sweeping drone footage of the Fort Hill, Hellshire Park Estate and Seafort communities, Mr Julal shared details of the camera system installed at the Fort Clarence Roundabout. *Cont Pg. 2*

The high resolution camera system equipped with licence plate detection, facial recognition as well as night vision features has been strategically deployed in key areas.

AHLC Chairman Delford Julal said that the installation of the surveillance system is the first phase of a four-phase plan to better secure the area. Minister of National Security Dr Horace Chang and Commissioner of Police Major General Anthony Anderson, praised the residents for their efforts.

Minister Chang pledged to offer support for their future endeavours, with a major CCTV system for the broader Portmore region in the works.

Mr Julal endorsed the accolades for JCF St. Catherine South Division Neighbourhood Watch Coordinator, Corporal Mikey Lord, who did an excellent job leading the process from training to launch. The sentiments were heard and acknowledged by Commissioner Anderson, who declared "That sounds like a Sargeant!" He stood by his word, with the announcement of his official promotion made just days later. The AHLC heartily congratulates Sargeant Mikey Lord and looks forward to a continued positive and productive working relationship.
